

# Round Cushion Tutorial

## MATERIEAL

velvet border  
Matching fabric  
2 large buttons  
Filling

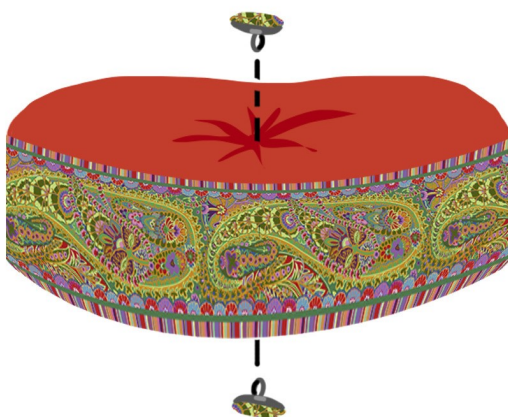
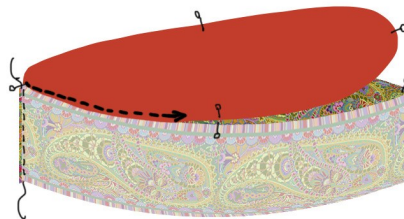
Level: Easy

## ROUND CUSHION

sample :  
 $98 \text{ cm} / 3.14 = 31.2 \text{ cm}$



100 cm (98cm + 2 cm pour les coutures )



- 1 Put 2 circles in a fabric matching your border,  
(diameter according to the size of your border, remember your geometry lessons: length of your border divided by 3.14 = diameter of your fabric circle)  
Remember to add 2 cm to the length of your border for seam allowance.

- 2 Make a mark at the quarters of the circles and the border to make it easier to fit together. Stitch the velvet strip right sides together to make a circle.  
Stitch the strip to the first circle, right sides together, making sure the marks coincide.  
Do the same with the second circle but leave a 10cm opening to turn the cushion over.  
If you want to add a zipper insert one 45cm long instead of the opening .

- 3 Turn the cushion right sides out. Stuff with polyester fibre and close with a few discreet stitches (if no zipper)

Optional : you can add buttons to the middle of the two sides, stitching from one side of the cushion to the other.

**Tip:** You can find buttons that are easy to cover at the haberdashery, so you can choose the same fabric as the cushion or a scrap with an interesting pattern.
