



## Little Basket

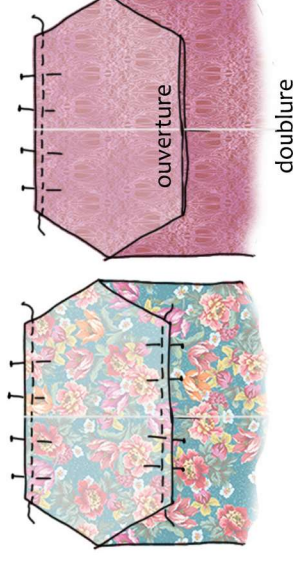
### You will need :

- 1 cotton (40 x 27 cm )for the outside (or half a fat quarter)
- 1 cotton (40cm x 27cm) for the lining (or half a fat quarter)
- 40 x 27 cm light iron-on fleece (I like the H 630 from viseline)
- A piece of cardboard or jeffitex for the bottom of

- 1 Print out the pattern twice on paper and cut out the basket patterns, tape them together on the side marked "fold".  
-Iron the fleece to the back of the lining.  
-Overlay the fabric and lining, pin the pattern to the fabric and cut (1 cm seam allowance is included)  
Also cut out a 14 x 4 cm strip for the attachment loop.



- 2 -Fold the fabric right sides together, stitch the back and bottom of the basket. Repeat for the lining.

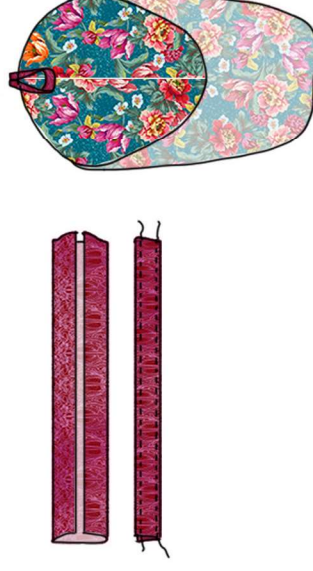


- 3 -Align the seams and stitch the darts.

Repeat for the lining, but leave one dart open.

- 4 -Fold the edges of the strip towards the centre, fold in half and topstitch (you can also use a pretty ribbon if you prefer)

Form a loop and pin to the top of the basket, in line with the seam.



- 5 -Turn the basket inside out and slide it into the other basket, right sides together.

-Pin making sure the seams coincide, stitch 5mm from the edge.

-Turn back through the opening in the lining.

-Topstitch the edge of the basket at 3mm.

S-slide a 10 x 7.5 cm cardboard or jeffitex rectangle at the bottom of the basket. Close by hand with a few discreet
