











MATERIAL

Velvet border Matching fabric Braids (optional) Filling

LEVEL: easy

RECTANGULAR CUSHION

- 1 Cut 2 rectangles from a fabric that matches your border, (we used fleece or minky fabric for a really cosy cushion!)
 Cut the border to the desired size.
- 2 Make a small 5mm fold on each long edge of the border, iron on the reverse side, protecting the fabric with baking paper.

Pin and stitch the border 3mm from the edges on the face of the cushion.

3 To close the cushion, 2 options:

1: if you are a beginner (or in a hurry!) With right sides together, sew around the edge of the cushion, leaving a 10 cm opening at the bottom to turn it over. Turn it over in the right direction. Stuff with polyester fibre and close with a few discreet stitches.

2: If you are comfortable with installing zippers you can add one before assembling the 2 sides of the cushion and slip an existing cushion into this cover.

Tip: putting a braid on the edge of the velvet will bring an original and refined touch to your creation!
