

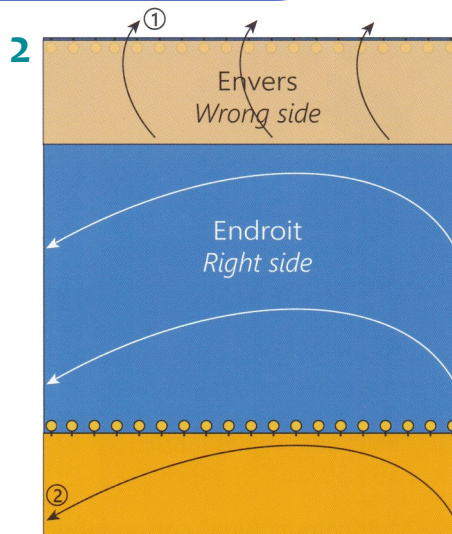
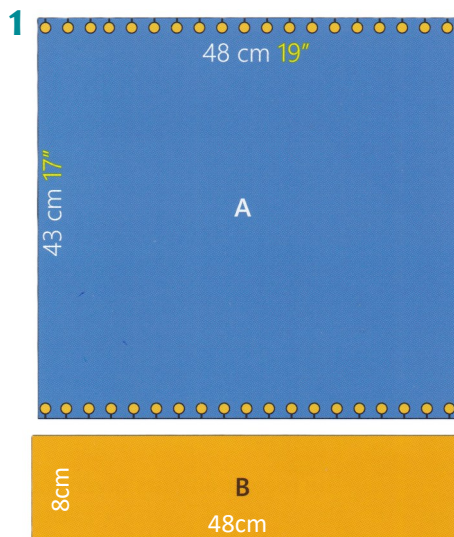
# Tutorial Neckroll



## MATERIAL

Supple Velvet 50cm x 50cm (20"x 20" )  
1 fat quarter cotton (45x55cm) (18"x 21" )  
1m pompom trim  
2 buttons (about 3cm)  
Padding

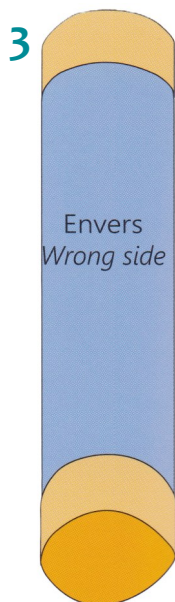
## CUTTING AND ASSEMBLY



- 1** From the supple velvet cut a rectangle 43cm x 48cm (19"x 17" )  
From the cotton cut 2 rectangles de 8cm x 48cm (3 1/4 "x 19" )

If you have a striped fabric assemble 3 pieces 8cm wide then cut to size so stripes are in the right direction.

Position one pompom trim on each of the small side of rectangle A, with the pompoms oriented towards the centre.  
Baste stitch in place



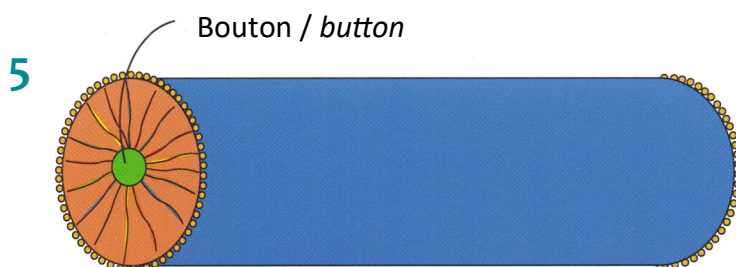
- 2** Position one B rectangle above each trim right sides together.  
Sew at 7mm (1/4") from the edge.  
Fold back the B rectangles.

- 3** Fold the ensemble in 2, right sides together, with the long sides together. Sew to create a tunnel.



- 4** Pass a strong gathering thread through each end of the tunnel.  
Gather one of the ends and firmly sew one of the buttons onto the centre of the pleats.

- 5** Generously fill the tunnel with the padding. Gather the remaining end, firmly tie the thread and sew on the remaining button.



**TIP:** Thread a solid thread from one button through the cushion to the other, pull and fix to give the ends a nice aspect.
