




MATERIAL

Velvet border: 50 cm
Matching cotton fabric 80 x 140cm
Ribbon for ties: 4 X 30 cm
Batting 50 x 80
Bias binding 2.70m
Magic pen!

LEVEL: medium Seam allowance: 8 mm



- 1 Cut the cotton pieces as shown in the diagram (check that the measurements fit your machine)
- Trace the quilting on the top rectangle with an air-erasable pen. Baste with large stitches to hold the 3 layers together.


Quilt by hand or machine, sandwiching the batting between the 2 cotton panels.





3 Stitch the top of the border with the pocket lining strip, right sides together.

Turn over, press and topstitch 3 mm from the edge.



Place the pocket on the quilted panel and stitch to hold the sides and bottom.

Stitch vertically to make 2 or 3 pockets as desired.

5 Stitch bias binding all around to finish and attach the 4 ties, checking the correct height for your sewing machine.

Tip: Place the panel under the machine when sewing so that you have everything at hand!
