





MATERIAL

Velvet border
Coloured suede or velvet
Coordinating Cotton fabric for the lining.
Iron-on fleece
5 mm round elastic
Button with tail

LEVEL: easy

Seam allowance: 1 cm

- 1 Cut your fabrics according to the size of your e-reader, tablet or mini computer. (To be adapted if your computer is larger). Once in the suede and once in the cotton.
- Heat seal the fleece to the back of the cotton.
- To apply the border there are several methods:

 1: Iron a 5mm fold along the long edge of the border (on the back and protecting the fabric) then stitch onto the suede with a topstitch 2mm from the edge.

 2: Stitch the border directly onto the suedette, hide the edge by stitching a braid or ribbon on top.
- 4 Right sides together, stitch the 2 short sides of the pouch, repeat for the lining but leave a 10 cm opening. Clip the corners.

 Right sides together, put the lining into the velvet pouch.
- 5 Slip a 12 cm loop of elastic between the two fabrics (at the centre point). Stitch the top of the pocket. Turn right sides out and close the opening. Topstitch 5 mm from the edge. Slide your device into the pouch to check where to sew the button.
