



MATERIAL

Velvet border 13 cm wide Matching fabric for lining Thin iron-on fleece Rounded purse frame 10cm


LEVEL : medium

seam allowance: 5 mm

Cut a 92 cm velvet border, cut a cotton strip for the lining 92 x 14 cm and the same in the fleece.
 (check with your knitting needle size) Heat seal the fleece to the back of your lining.
 On the reverse side, trace the shape of the clasp on each end of the velvet strip.

Do the same with the lining.

Pold the border right sides together, pin and stitch the sides upto the tracing. Do the same with the lining but leave a 10 cm opening for turning.



4 Slide the fabric into the clasp and sew it with strong thread (start in the middle to avoid shifting when sewing).

Tip: Velvet is very easy to embroider, take advantage of this to personalise your pretty pouch even more!
Opt for thicker threads that will show up well, beads, sequins...
