

MATERIAL

Velvet border : 44cm

Cotton fabric to match the border:
14 x 44 cm

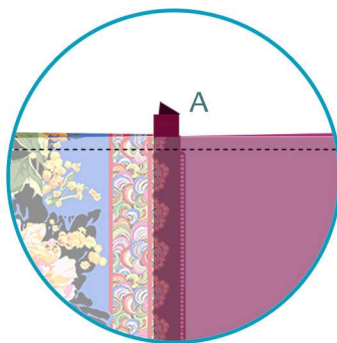
Iron-on fleece 14 x 44cm

20 cm nylon zipper

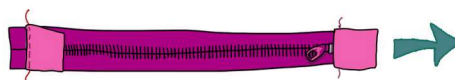
LEVEL : medium

Seam allowance: 1 cm

Tutorial Zipper pouch



- 1 Cut the border into 2 pieces of 22 cm, Iron the fleece to the back of the cotton and cut 2 identical rectangles for the lining. Overlap a rectangle of velvet and a rectangle of cotton, right sides together. Slide the zipper between the 2 fabrics, rights side of zip towards the velvet. Stitch through all layers, preferably with a "special zipper foot" to be as close as possible to the zip stitches. Do the same with the other 2 rectangles of fabric and the other part of the zip.
- 2 Lay the pouch flat, iron on the cotton side and topstitch at 3mm on either side of the zipper.
- 3 Place the fabric so that the velvet is against the velvet and the cotton in against cotton, right sides together. (by positioning the teeth of the zipper towards the cotton (A). remember to leave the zipper half open)
- 4 Stitch all the way around the pouch but leave 8 cm open on the lining side to turn it over
- 5 Clip the corners and turn right side out, pushing the lining into the velvet.



Tip: If your zipper is too small, you can sew 2 small pieces of fabric at the ends to make it longer.
